



On Easter Mass believers take communion.



LIGHT A GANDLE - TRADITION



On Easteras as it is one of the most important holidays in the church celebrates a solemn service.



Tradition requires at midnight between Saturday and Sunday to go to church. Bells driven because it comes an extraordinary day - Easter. On this day as Christians believe Jesus was resurrected.



Painted eggs are being knocked On Easter.

Person whose egg is not broken will be most happy throughout the year.

This egg is called "Boracay".



On Maundy Thursday, when Christ takes up his cross - eggs are painted in red and Easter buns are prepared. They are given to friends and relatives for health














On Easter 45 days fasting is over. For the first time you can eat greasy foods. The family brings festive table.







CUSTOMS

In Bulgaria, the tradition is to paint the eggs on Maundy Thursday or Holy Saturday, and their number depends on the family members. The first is always colored in red by the oldest female. She paints a cross sign on the foreheads of children, and then on everyone else from the family.
